This homestay is known for its breath-taking views, its hospitality and of course an amazing WiFi speed. The fast wi-fi reaches most corners of the estate. There are lots of areas where you can sit and work, both inside and out. Since it never gets hot, outside is often preferred. There is a small orchard on a ridge with overwhelming views at dawn, dusk, and snow-capped peaks (on a clear day). It is surrounded by greenery and tranquillity and can be a great antidote to crowds and the boredom of working from your bedroom. A lot of effort has been made to make the homestay as eco-friendly as possible.



It is a serene and private escape. The homestay tastefully decorated and welcoming rooms are surrounded by lush green mountains. An ideal place to relax rejuvenate the soul, and uplift your mood.

We live in a rural area and the electric supply can be unpredictable. We have solar water heaters and solar electricity backup that feeds the library/lounge and guest rooms in the main house. In winters we light the bukhari in the lounge to make it a cosy space for hanging out. We will also provide you with hot water bottles on such nights.

## Our Rooms

### MAIN HOUSE ROOMS:



Our two main house rooms are large wood floored rooms with a shared lounge which is accessible from within the room. They have 2 single or joined into 1 double bed and nice furniture including a desk & chair.

There is pretty green foliage visible from the windows.



Attached to each room is an en-suite bathroom, newly renovated with posh ceramic fittings.

THE COBB-SUITES:



We have four charming, eco-friendly cobb-Suites, in a rustic but beautiful structure. These are about 50 metres from the main house. Two are at the upper level and two are at the lower level.

Each Cobb-Suite has two rooms and can comfortably accommodate 3 people all on beds. They have large plate glass bay windows from which you can view the greenery and the mountains.



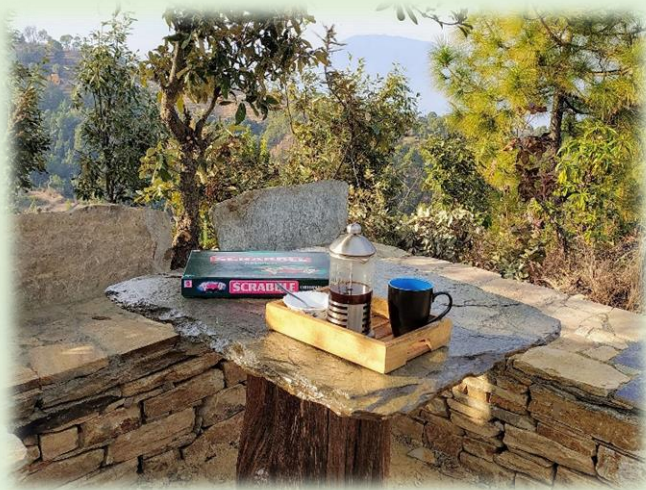
They have two desks and its own sit out/balcony.

Very fast wi-fi (100 MBPS)

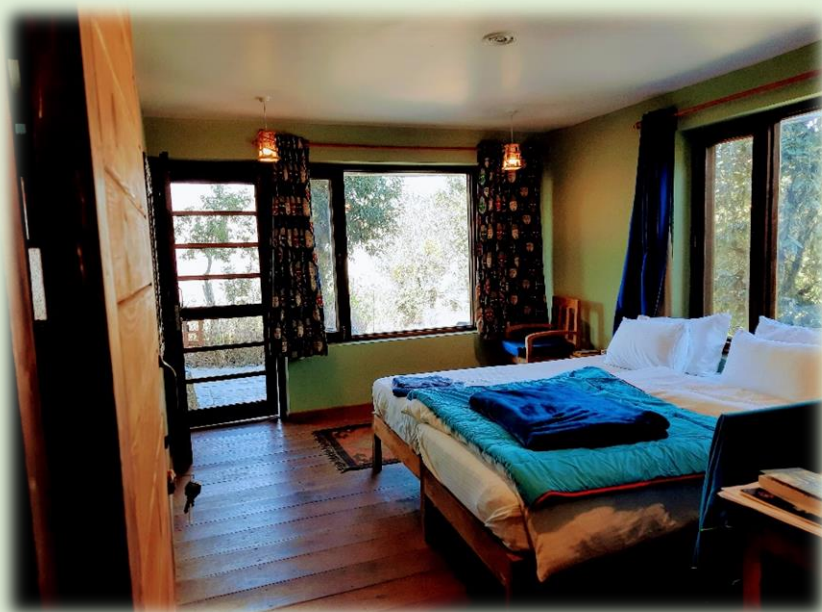
Heating and hot water bottles in the winter

## ADVENTURE ACTIVITIES AT THE HOMESTAY



Every dawn and dusk bring magical colours here, and always touches something deep within. Here, you can live without fear, move around freely.

You can play badminton, or spend time on the basketball half court on our homestay. If you prefer long walks, head to the forest reserve, which is just 2 kms away. It's a well-kept secret few know about, but teems in wildlife such as Jackals, sambar, barking deer, wild boar, and leopards.

Our homestay is a favourite with creative people, and is the venue for all the events of the Himalayan Writing Retreat. There is also a Basketball half-court. We don't like loud noise, karaoke etc. Lots of indoor games. Bonfire / barbeque are available only on request at an additional charge.

## PLACES OF INTEREST AROUND

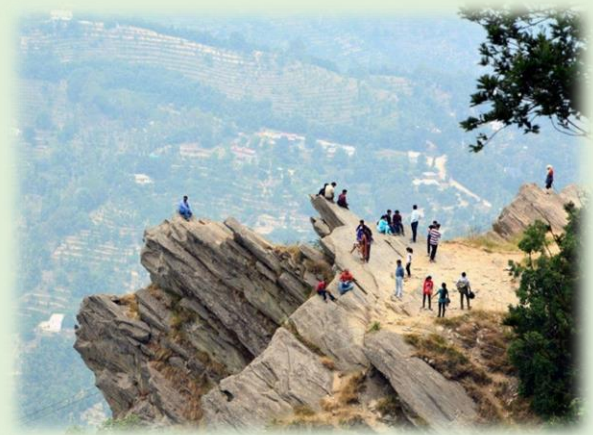
### DHOKANEY FALL



It is a stunning waterfall hidden amidst the pines is a local secret of the region. Owing to its location, it's a lesser crowded spot and only people from the Dhokaney village can be seen here on sunny afternoons.

### CHAULI KI JALI

A panoramic view of the rocky hills spreading across the Kumaon Valley. Explore the interesting, sharp rock formations, which grant fertility to any woman who touches them, according to local folklore. Keep your eyes peeled for a distinctive rock with a circular hole in it, perhaps the most interesting formation in the area.



### JAGESHWAR TEMPLES



Are a group of 124 ancient Hindu temples dated between 7th and 14th century near Almora, in the Himalayan Indian state of Uttarakhand. The valley has a number of temple clusters such as the Dandeshwar and Jageshwar sites.

## ORCHARDS AT RAMGARH

A small town; Ramgarh is a tourist attraction for anyone who wants to spend leisure time around orchards. The main orchard attractions of the town are of apple, apricot and peach, all of them found in abundance. The small town was home to renowned writers like Padma Vibhushan Mahadevi Verma, Narayan Swami, and Rabindranath Tagore.



## PEORA



Peora is the fruit bowl of Uttarakhand, located in the Kosyakutoli Tehsil of Nainital district. This eco-tourism spot offers beautiful views of the Himalayan ranges. The entire village and its surroundings are adorned with Sal, pine, oak, buruns, kaphal and rhododendron trees. Bird watching, game watching, and trekking are the popular activities enjoyed by the travellers visiting Peora.

*(The destinations mentioned above are at a driving distance ranging for 40 minutes to 2.5 hrs from the Homestay. You will need to hire a Taxi/car for the same at extra charges)*

## HOW TO GET HERE

Fly to Delhi. Then take any of the following:

**By Road:** The retreat is a 9-hour drive from Delhi, but it is traffic dependent. People have made it in under eight hours too. The nearest big town is Mukteshwar, which is 12 km by road from us (shorter if you walk).

**Train:** in normal times, there are three trains a day to Kathgodam (the nearest train station). Most people prefer to take the Kathgodam Shatabdi (Delhi departure: 6.20 AM, Kathgodam Arrival: 11.40 AM) is running right now. A cab from Kathgodam to Satkhol takes about 2.5 hrs

**Air:** the nearest airport is Pantnagar. There are four 4 flights a week from Delhi. A cab from Pantnagar to Satkhol takes about 3.5 hr.
