We offer guests an opportunity to spend stress-free time in the serene environment surrounded by fruit and vegetable fields that provide seasonal supplies for the homestay. Waking up to the chirping sound of various species of birds is an experience to savour. At night, you can sit under the canopy of stars, on the wide-open lawn outside.

OUR ROOMS

DELUXE ROOMS



We have Two Deluxe rooms, and they are called Monal and Kasturi.

Each room can accommodate Two guests on a double-bed and have attached bathrooms. The rooms also have a seating area inside and ample storage.



You can admire a beautiful view of the mountains from the bed. The room is very spacious and an extra bed can easily be provided. They also have a sit out window and a private balcony.

FAMILY ATTIC ROOMS:



Our attic rooms are spectacular two-level suites. It comprises a spacious master bedroom with a Queen-size bed on the ground floor.

There are two mattresses which serve as twin beds on the top floor. A wooden staircase takes you from the room to the attic.

ACTIVITIES AROUND OUR PLACE

Fruit Orchards & Organic Farms

From May-June enjoy fresh fruits from the orchards around you. Savour fresh plucked Plums, Peaches, Apples, Pears, Apricots. Depending on the season one can explore the area and enjoy watching varied vegetation like Peas, Corn, Rajma, Haldi, Kumaoni Raddish and many more.

Bird Watching

Mixed forests dominated by thick oak, pine and rhododendron (Buransh) cover most of the area and surrounding hills. With many forests and trekking trails, the area is also known to have a huge number of species of birds, making it a delight for bird watchers. You can spot Black Drogo, Dove, Common Rose-flinch, Eurasian Jay, Green backed tit amongst many others.

Panoramic View Of Himalayan Peaks

On a clear day, you can take a short walk & see breath-taking views of the snow-clad Himalayan peaks. You can get to see, Trishul, Nanda Devi, Panchachuli. According to the local folktale, on a clear sunny day the mountain peaks look like Lord Shiva lying down and mesmerized, you see Lord Shiva taking a nap right in front of your eyes.

Explored And Unexplored Trails

Go for jungle walks in the woods. It is advisable to take along a local villager who knows the path well to avoid losing your path in the verdant forests. There are endless walking trails in the adjoining forests that will inspire anyone. The only sounds you'll hear are the chirp-ing of birds, the rustling of leaves filled with the crisp mountain air. Beautiful trails of dry leaves, twigs and rocks, surrounded by oaks and rhododendrons makes short treks around this area, is a must-do activity.

A River Nearby

There is beautiful river, which is not too deep, hence perfect to enjoy, play, bath or just relax...with your feet in the cold water ...all of it making your trek worthwhile. An ideal place to plan a day's picnic. A beautiful one hours' trek or a 6 km drive will take you to this beautiful spot.

POINTS TO NOTE:

There is a walk of about 3-4 minutes from the road to the cottages of around 30 steps. This makes the place, non- wheelchair friendly. People who can walk is no problem as walk is not steep and there is a railing for the stairs.

PLACES OF INTEREST AROUND

DHOKANEY FALL



It is a stunning waterfall hidden amidst the pines is a local secret of the region. Owing to its location, it's a lesser crowded spot and only people from the Dhokaney village can be seen here on sunny afternoons.

CHAULI KI JALI

A panoramic view of the rocky hills spreading across the Kumaon Valley. Explore the interesting, sharp rock formations, which grant fertility to any woman who touches them, according to local folklore. Keep your eyes peeled for a distinctive rock with a circular hole in it, perhaps the most interesting formation in the area.



JAGESHWAR TEMPLES



Are a group of 124 ancient Hindu temples dated between 7th and 14th century near Almora, in the Himalayan Indian state of Uttarakhand. The valley has a number of temple clusters such as the Dandeshwar and Jageshwar sites.

ORCHARDS AT RAMGARH

A small town; Ramgarh is a tourist attraction for anyone who wants to spend leisure time around orchards. The main orchard attractions of the town are of apple, apricot and peach, all of them found in abundance. The small town was home to renowned writers like Padma Vibhushan Mahadevi Verma, Narayan Swami, and Rabindranath Tagore.



PEORA



Peora is the fruit bowl of Uttarakhand, located in the Kosyakutoli Tehsil of Nainital district. This eco-tourism spot offers beautiful views of the Himalayan ranges. The entire village and its surroundings are adorned with Sal, pine, oak, buruns, kaphal and rhododendron trees. Bird watching, game watching, and trekking are the popular activities enjoyed by the travellers visiting Peora.

ABOUT NATHUAKHAN



Nathuakhan is a village nestled in the Ramgarh block of the Nainital district in the state of Uttarakhand. This beautiful travel destination rests deep within the scenic beauty and is part of the fruit belt of Kumaon Hills.

It is close to the towns of Mukteshwar and Nainital. It is at an altitude of 1940 meters- 6360 Ft above sea and has a pleasant climate throughout the year. Nathuakhan is known for its picturesque beauty.





The alluring views of the Himalayan ranges and thickly forested hill-sides with trees of pine, oak, and kafal trees, makes it a favourite destination, more so in winter.

HOW TO GET HERE

Fly to Delhi. Then take any of the following:

By Road: The retreat is a 9-hour drive from Delhi, but it is traffic dependent. People have made it in under eight hours too. The nearest big town is Mukteshwar, which is 19 km by road.


Train: in normal times, there are three trains a day to Kathgodam (the nearest train station). Most people prefer to take the Kathgodam Shatabdi (Delhi departure: 6.20 AM, Kathgodam Arrival: 11.40 AM) is running right now. Our place is 60 kms away and you can hire a cab.


Air: the nearest airport is Pantnagar. There are four 4 flights a week from Delhi. A cab from Pantnagar to our place takes about 4 hours.
