



PS-005–A traditional exposed Laterite Stone home in Poothali, Kerala



ABOUT US



This is a homestay located in a coastal village called Ananthanpalla, near Nileswar. It is a great location for a relaxed holiday, but also the ideal place to get your creative juices flowing.

A village road turns off from highway near Padannakad overbridge, winds languidly through villages and ends near a paddy field, where you can see Poothali-in the local vernacular translates to Indian Waterlily.



The gated home itself, is beautiful, having been built in traditional Kerala style, using red coloured exposed laterite stone. The interiors are aesthetically beautiful with the furniture made in intricately carved wood by local artisans. The heritage kind of upper floor offers the best-in-class dining space and a vast red oxide floor for yoga, meditation etc. You can enjoy a hot cup of tea, as you a read a book in the balcony, or watch the skies changing colours.

There are manicured lawns & gardens around it. You have soothing views of green paddy fields & tall swaying coconut trees. The sea breeze keeps the place nice & cool.

Around the property, you may spot birds and an occasional rabbit. It is just 1.8KMs away from a peaceful secluded beach, which you can easily walk across to.



ROOMS IN THE HOMESTAY

The cottage has 3 well-appointed bedrooms.

FOOD:

This place is a haven for traditional Kerala cuisine, both Veg and Non-veg of course including some delicious sea food dishes too.





Normally we have a south Indian menu, which is homemade.



We serve all meals at the property.



The chef and caretaker are residing in another house, which is just a compound wall away. Food will be served as per guest's choice.

ACTIVITIES AROUND THE HOMESTAY:



One can walk around the fields, village, even some streams around. Guided village trails are chargeable.

Go to the beach which is just 1.2 kms, for a stroll or a swim.



You can go for a boat ride in the backwaters

You can even book a cruise on the river in a very posh houseboat. (Chargeable extra)



SIGHTSEEING:

There are many interesting places to visit, if you hire a taxi. Some of them are:

BEKAL FORT -25 KMS AWAY



The fort appears to emerge from the sea. Almost three-quarters of its exterior is in contact with water. Bekal fort was not an administrative centre and does not include any palaces or mansions.

An important feature is the water-tank, magazine and the flight of steps leading to an observation tower. The fort's zigzag entrance and surrounding trenches reveal its defensive strategy. Holes on the outer walls are designed to defend the fort effectively from naval attacks.

PAYYANUR / VALIYAPARAMBA BACKWATERS - by taxi it's 22KMs

Valiyaparamba Backwaters is a region of great natural beauty. A boat cruise in traditional 'kettuvallams' (houseboats) offers panoramic view of the coconut groves in this island. The sight of boats chugging along in the calmness of the waters, coconut lagoons, variety of sea birds, the view of the sea further down and the sunset just adds to the beauty of the place.



PAYYANNUR TEMPLE -27 KMS



One of the most famous Lord Subramanya temples in Kerala, Sree Subramanya Swami Temple at Payyanur in Kannur district of Kerala has specific architectural significance. The two-storeyed sanctum sanctorum here is in the shape of Gajaprishtam [back of an elephant]. This temple also has a 6-ft tall idol of the main deity, Lord Subramanya. Another interesting feature is its 12ft tall compound wall that is constructed in a unique style.

ANANDASHRAM -10 KMS

Anandashram was founded by Swami Ramdas, endearingly called Beloved Papa, at Kanhangad, South India in 1931. "The ideal which the Ashram holds before it is Universal Love and Service based upon a vision of divinity in all beings and creatures of the world. Here every man, woman or child, to whatever denomination, creed or caste the person may belong, shall have free access."
