This property has two levels, the ground floor and the first floor and you can either book one of the levels or both levels (both have separate access).

## MEALS

Since you are booking the entire property including the kitchens, we don't serve any meals. Housekeeping is available daily from 9 am to 5.30 pm by our caretaker, who can help you with basic breakfast like bread butter / omelette, Maggi etc. Tea / coffee apart from cleaning.

However, the kitchen is fully equipped with basic cookware & crockery, refrigerator/micro / hotplate etc. Grocery store is round the corner at 50 meters. You can cook meals yourself, if you so desire, or order in from Zomato, Swiggy etc.

However, most guests prefer to go out and eat in the famous Dhabas and restaurants around this place.

## **PLACES OF INTEREST AROUND:**

There are several points of tourist interest in Amritsar besides the Golden temple which is so close to the Villa.

### **THE GOLDEN TEMPLE:**



The Golden Temple is a gurdwara located in the city of Amritsar, Punjab, India. It is the preeminent spiritual site of Sikhism. The temple is earthly representation of Milk Ocean of Vishnu/Hari. The word Harmandir means Hari's House.

### **JALIANWALA BAGH:**

This is a historic garden and 'memorial of national importance' close to the Golden Temple complex in Amritsar, Punjab, India, preserved in the memory of those wounded and killed in the Jallianwala Bagh Massacre that occurred on the site on the festival of Baisakhi, 13 April 1919



### **GOBINDGARH FORT:**



This is a historic military fort located in the centre of the city of Amritsar in the Indian state of Punjab. The Fort was until recently occupied by the army but was opened to the public from 10 February 2017

### GURUDWARA SHAHEED GANJ SAHIB:

This was built in homage to Sikh martyr Baba Deep Singh, with a stone where his severed head fell.



### WAGAH-ATTARI BORDER CEREMONY:



The lowering of the flags ceremony at the Attari-Wagah border is a daily military practice that the security forces of India and Pakistan have jointly followed since 1959.

### BABA ATAL TOWER:

This octagonal, nine-storeyed tower located south of the Golden temple, represents the nine years of the life of Atal Rai, son of the sixth Guru Hargobindji. The inner walls are decorated with frescoes on the life of Guru Nanak. The Adi Granth is enshrined within.



### PARTITION MUSEUM:



The museum aims to become the central repository of stories, materials, and documents related to the post-partition riots that followed the division of British India into two independent countries: India and Pakistan.

## KHALSA COLLEGE, AMRITSAR:

The Khalsa College, established way back in 1892, is a historic educational institution in the northern Indian city of Amritsar.

## GETTING HERE:

### BY AIR:



Sri Guru Ram Das Jee International Airport, 10 km away from Amritsar, is well linked with the rest of country and the world and there are regular flight services being offered by the major carriers for major Indian cities such as Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai, Bangalore and Srinagar. Besides, Air India Express, Uzbekistan Airways and Qatar Airways operate flights for Doha, Tashkent and Dubai.

### BY RAIL:



Amritsar railway station is well linked to all the important cities in Punjab along with other Indian cities and towns. There are frequent trains for Amritsar from Mumbai, Chennai, Hyderabad, Agra, Chandigarh and Kolkata, among others.

## BY ROAD:



One of the most convenient and pocket-friendly ways of travelling to Amritsar is by road. There are several states as well as private run buses operating from Delhi (460 km), Dharamsala (186 km), Dalhousie (176 km), Jammu (200 km) and Shimla (315 km). The G.T Road links Delhi and Amritsar.
